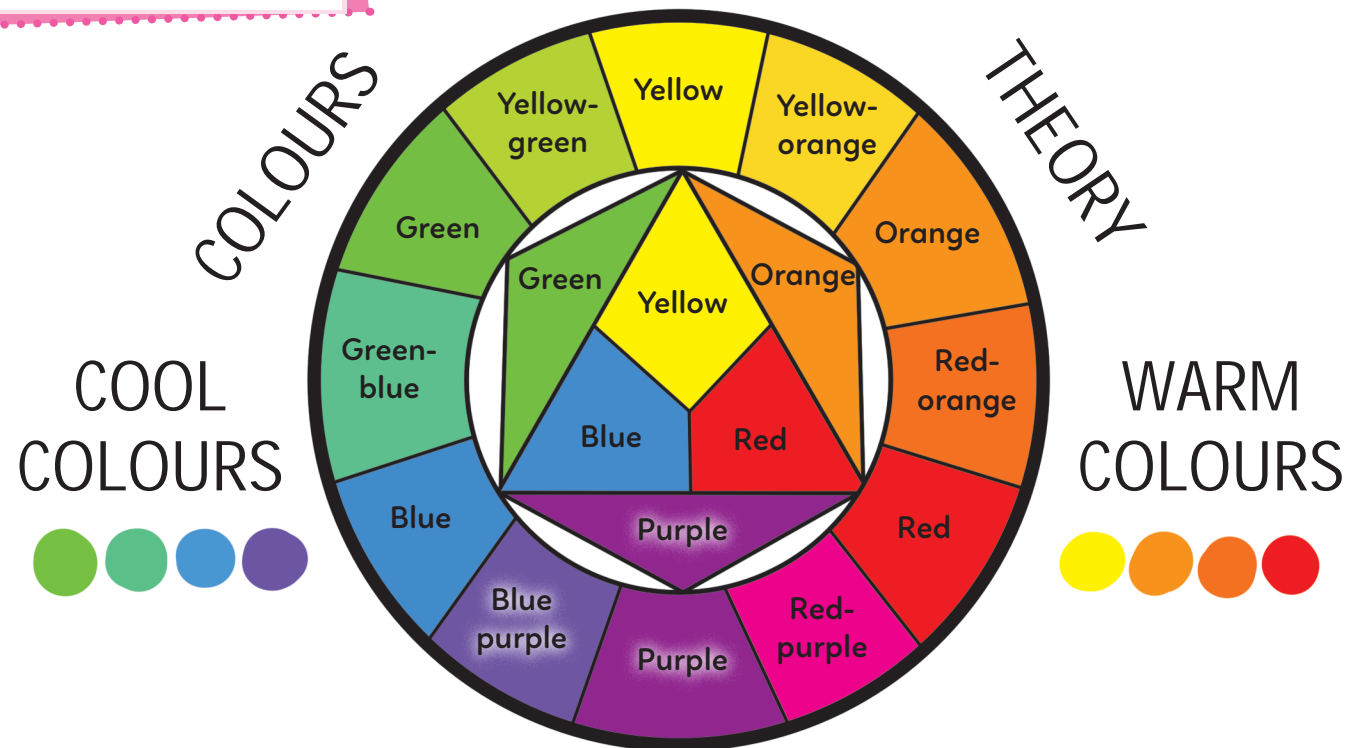

Mixing different amounts of the primary colours can make all the colours of the colour wheel.



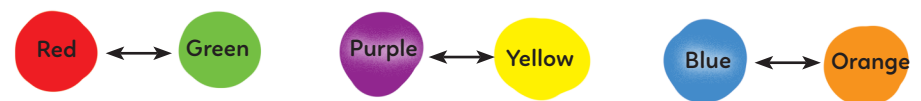
## Secondary

Mixing two primary colours make a secondary colour.



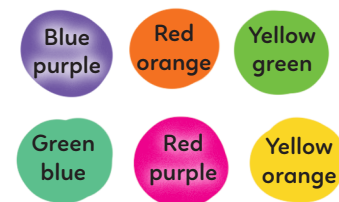
## Complementary

Colours opposite from each other on the colour wheel.



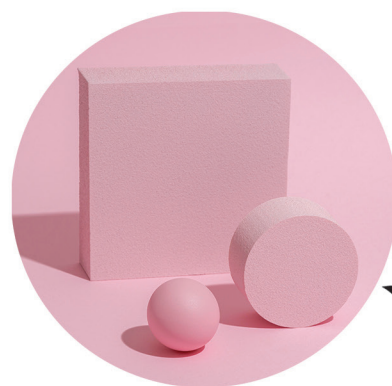
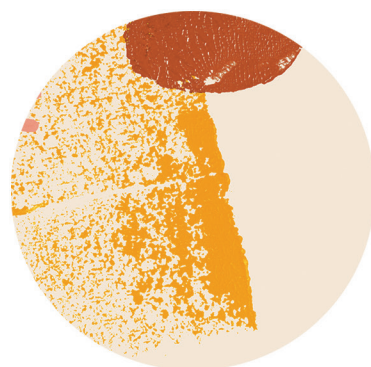
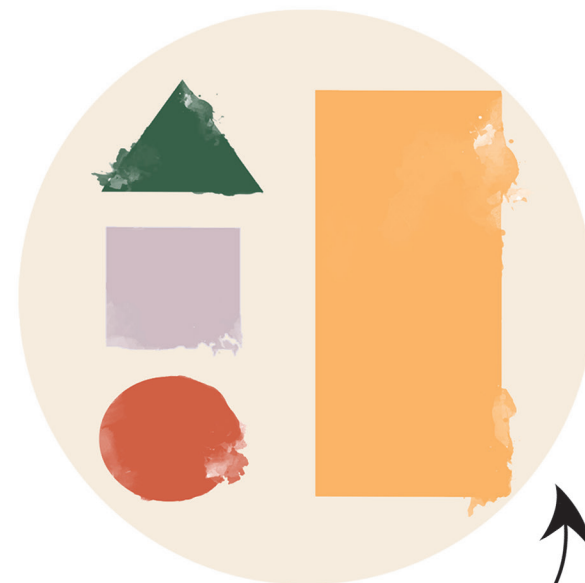

### MATERIALS REQUIRED

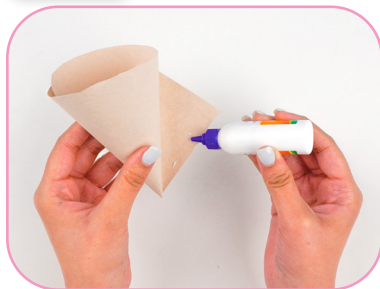

#### STEP 1



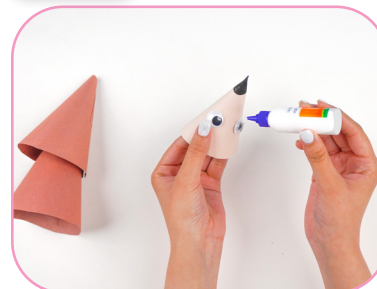
Roll the paper in a cone shape and then paste it as shown.

#### STEP 2



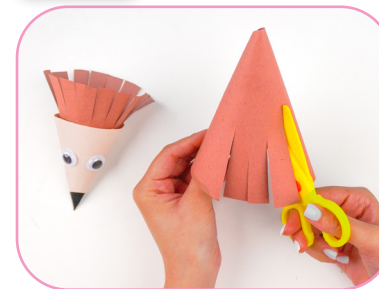
Make three identical cones (of same colour) and one cone of different colour as shown.

#### STEP 3



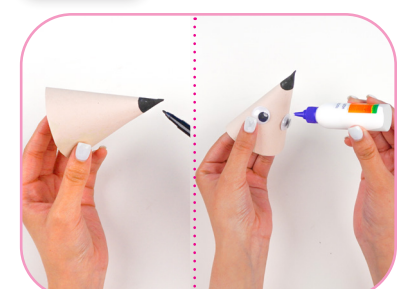
Paste the cones one inside the other as shown.

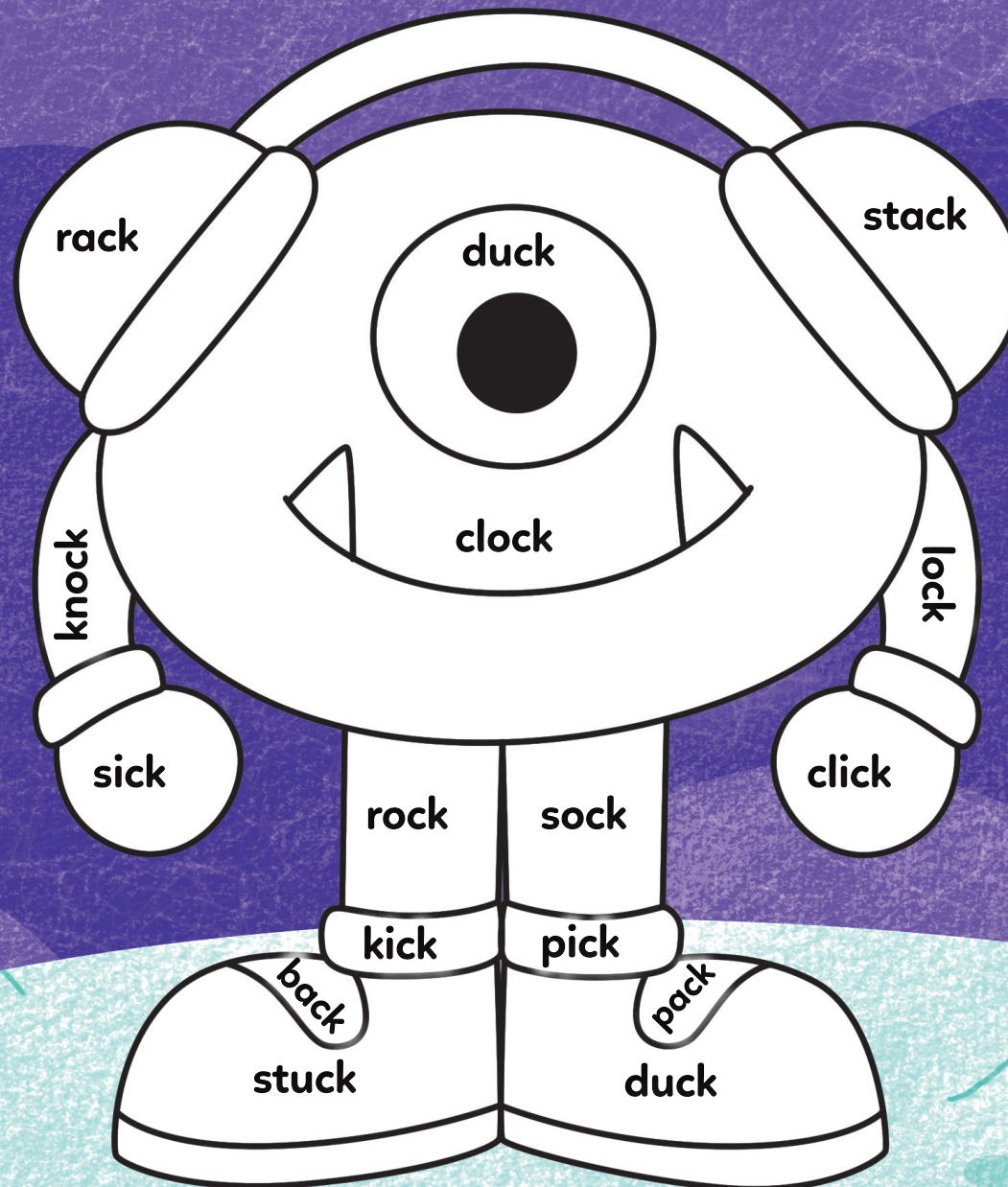

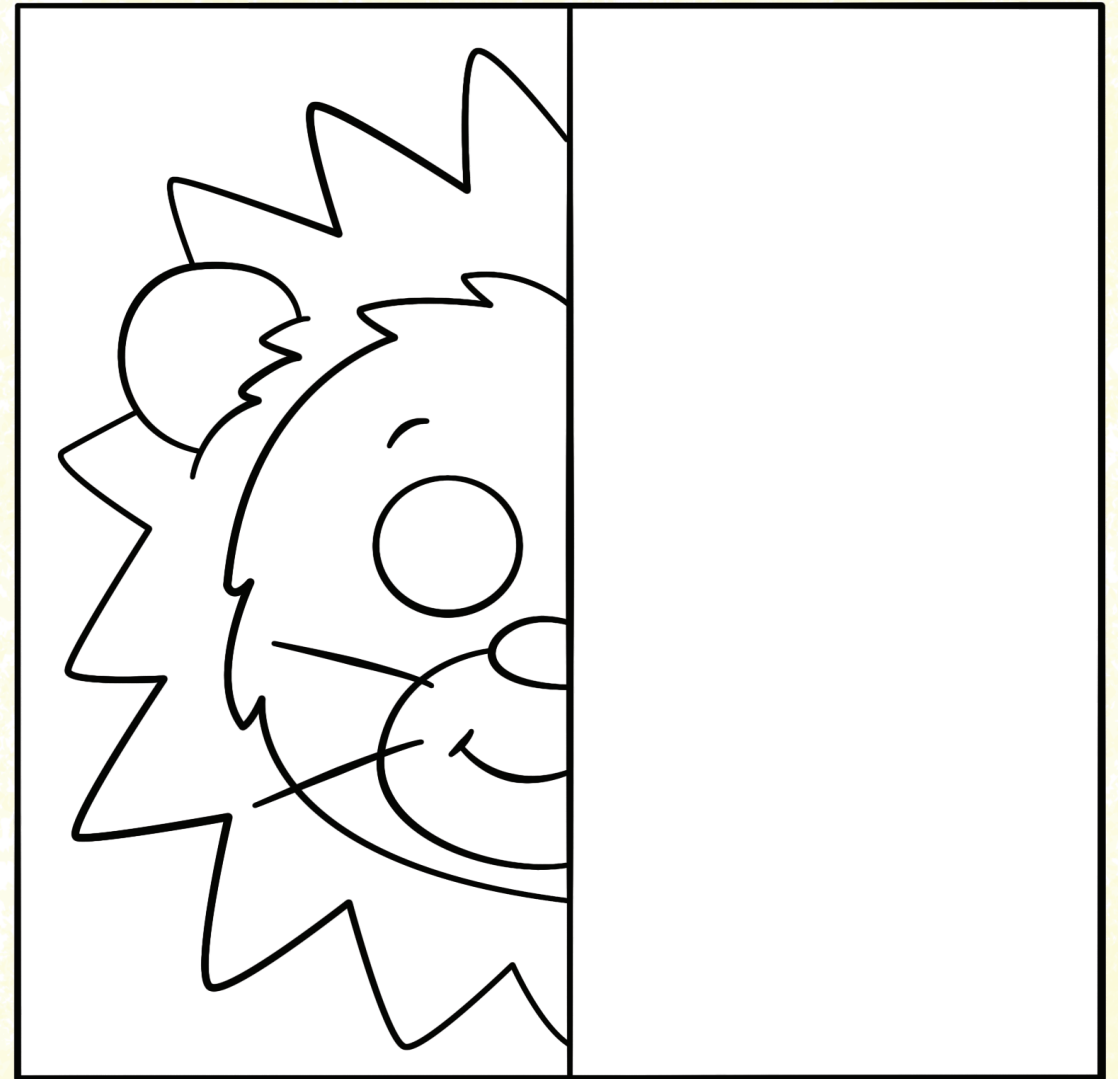
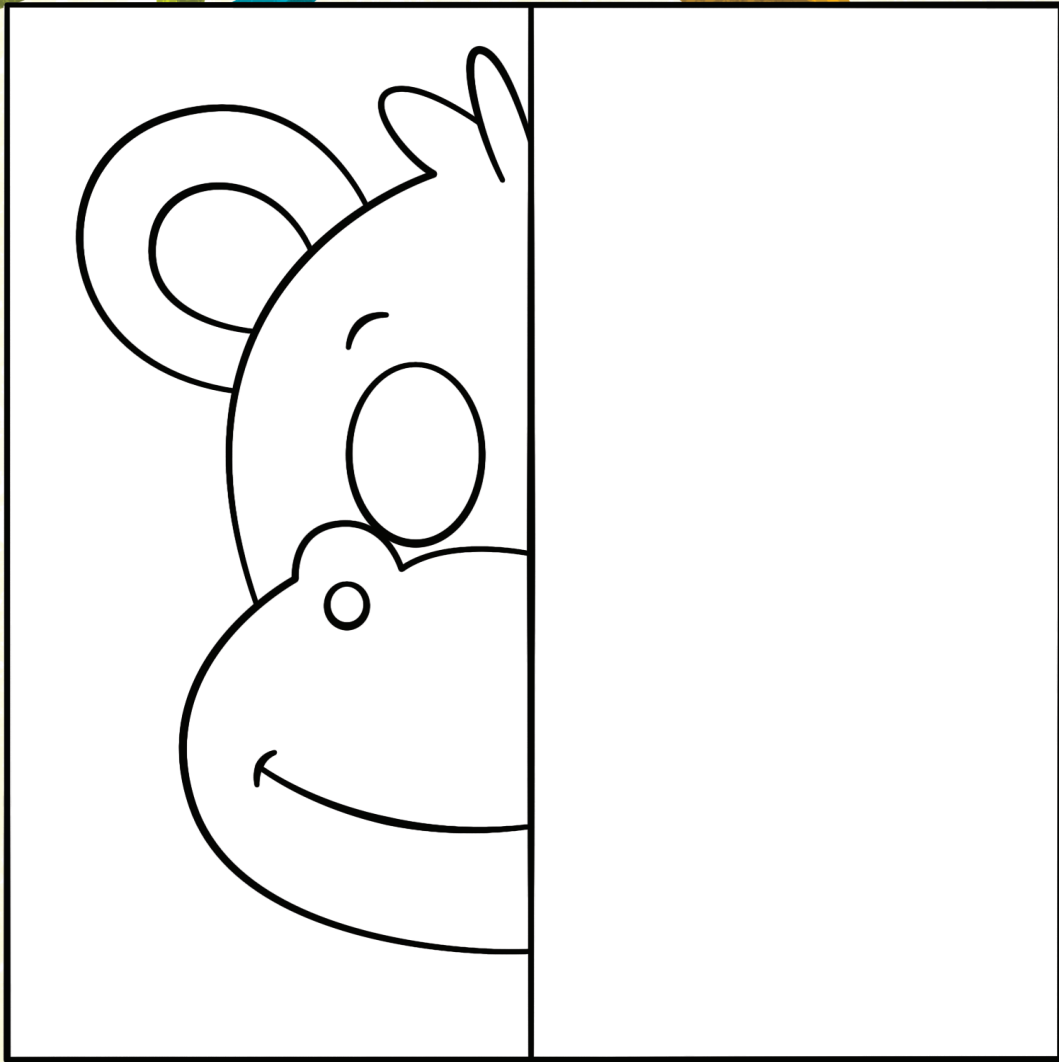

#### STEP 3



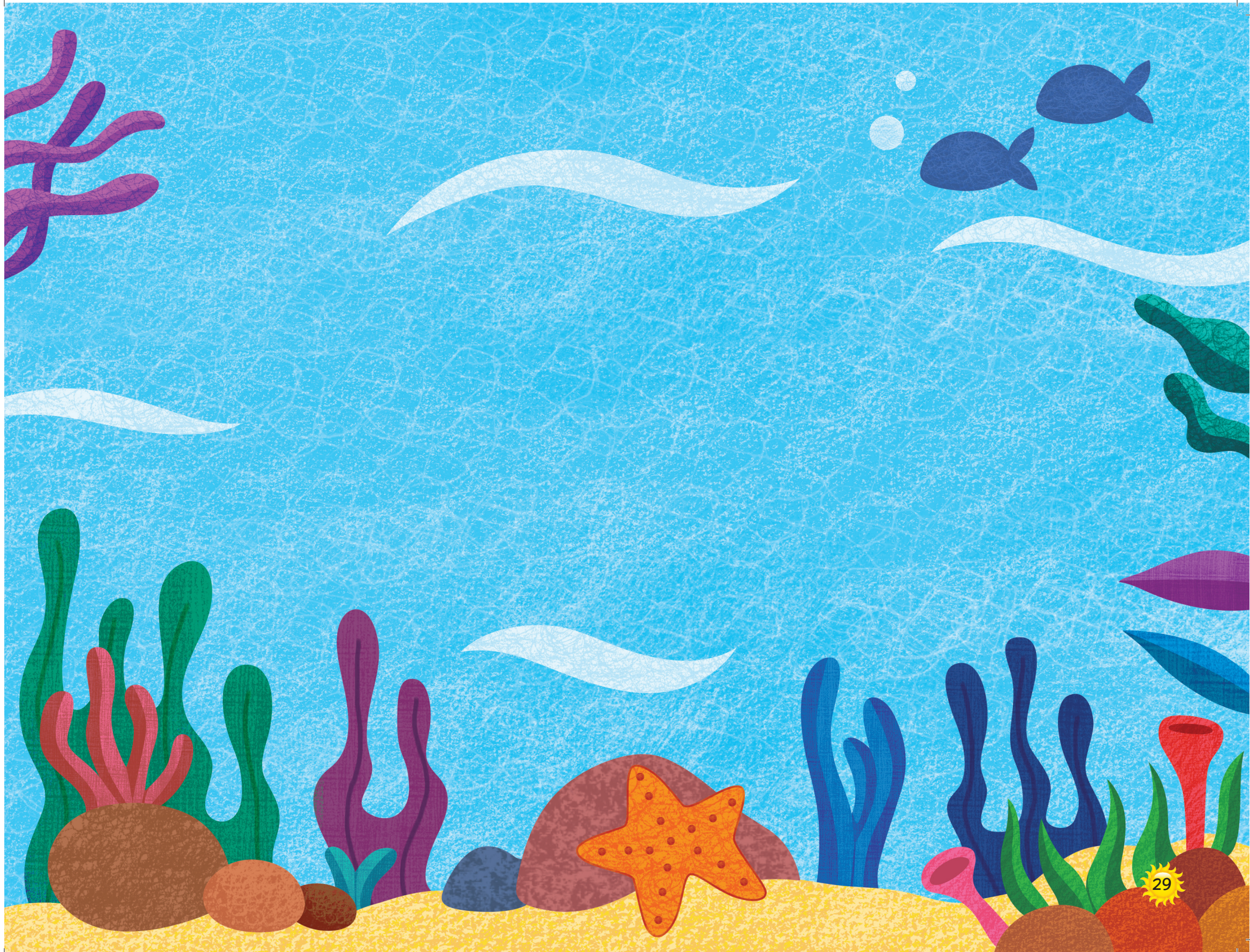
Use a black sketch pen to make eyes and face of the jelly fish.

- Glue



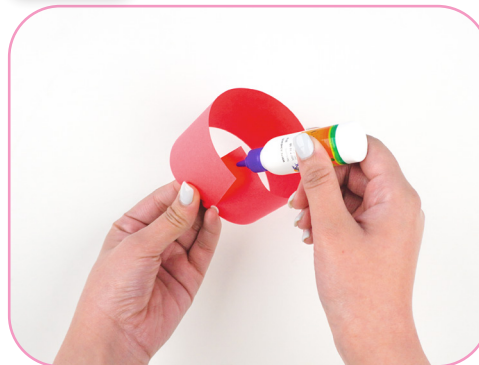
### FOLLOW THESE STEPS

#### STEP 3



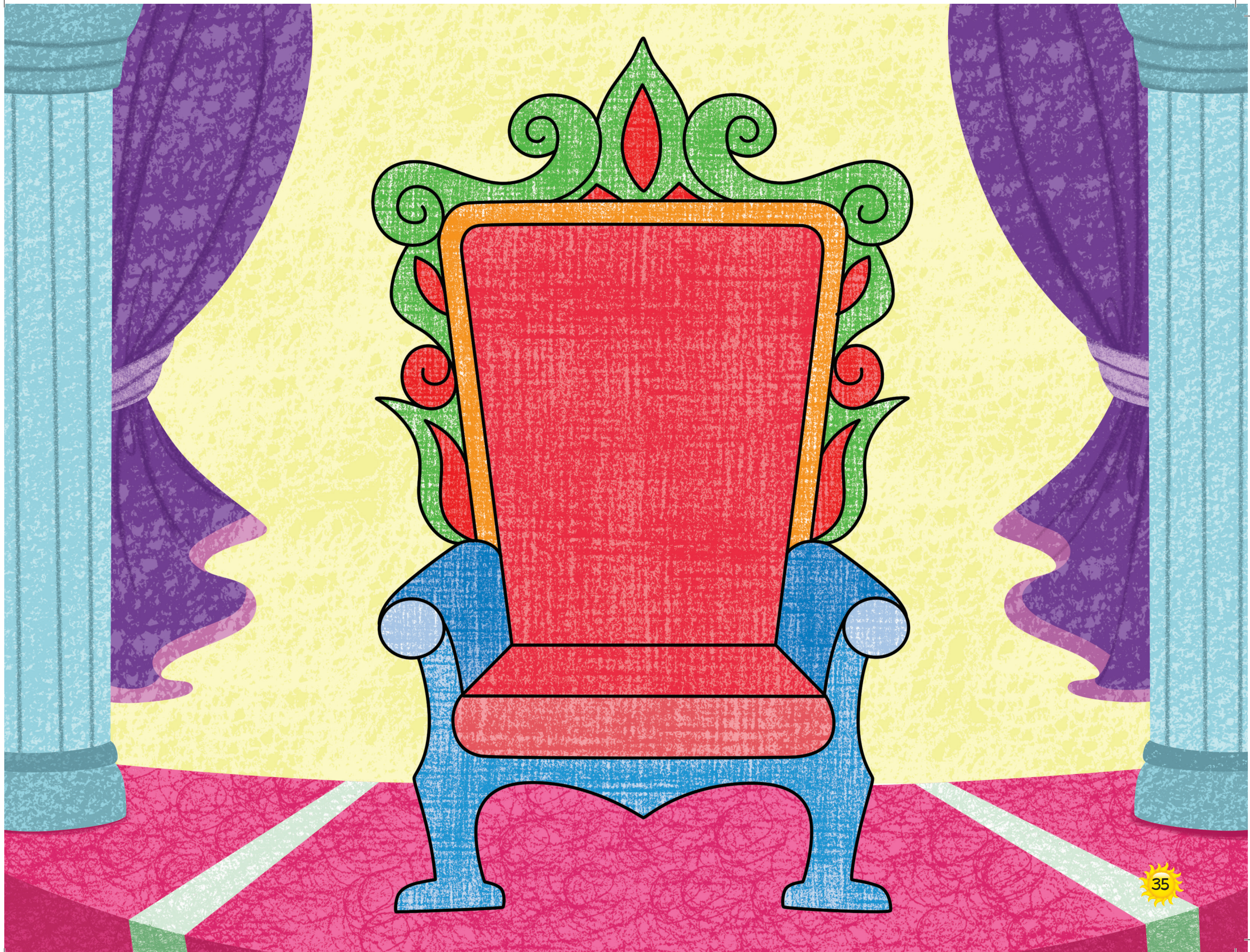
Cut the small rectangular paper strips of different colours and paste them on the paper roll as shown.

Paste wiggle eyes and pom-pom ball to make eyes and nose as shown.



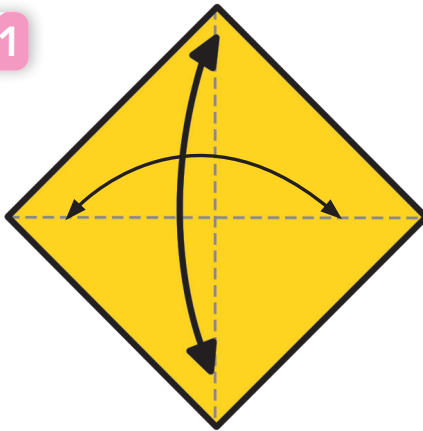






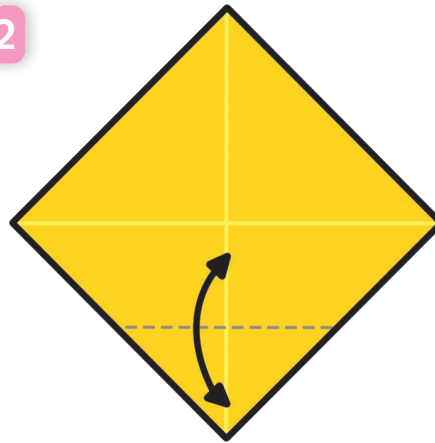

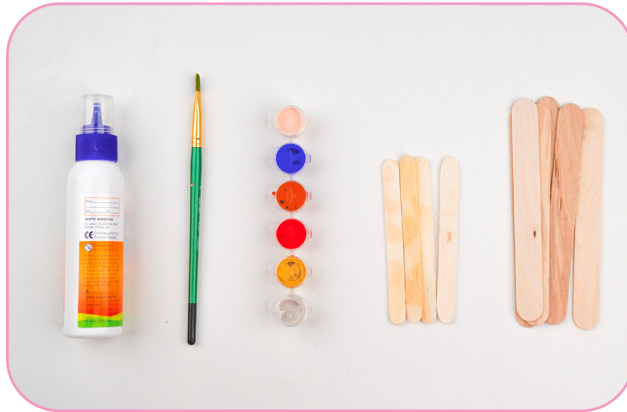




## EARRINGS STAND

Paste pencil peels on the whole dress of Princess to complete it.



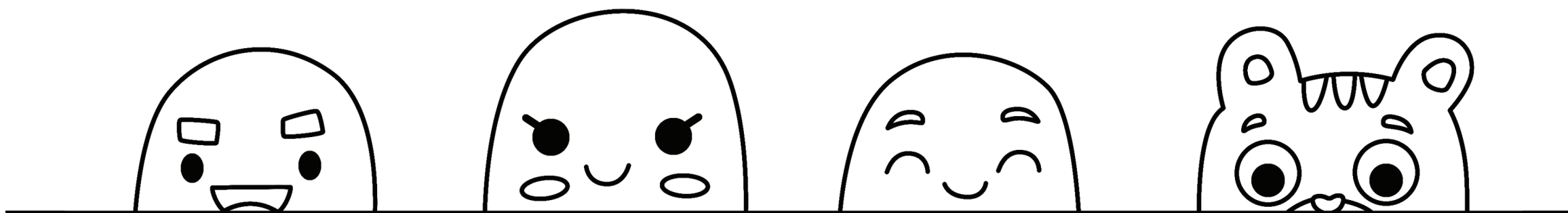
