

Primary

Mixing different amounts of the primary colours can make all the colours of the colour wheel.



Secondary

Mixing two primary colours make a secondary colour.



Analogous

Colours that are neighbours on the wheel.



Complementary

Colours opposite from each other on the colour wheel.



Tertiary

Primary colours and secondary colours are mixed together.



Monochromatic

A colour with its tints and shades. Tints are colours mixed with white. Shades are colours mixed with black.





We use the principles of art to organise the elements of art. It is the way we use elements to make the artwork more interesting.



Repetition of a motif shape, line, colour in a recognisable organisation.



Indicating movement by the repetition of elements.



The way an artist makes something in a work of art stand out.



Different lines, shapes, colours, and textures to make work of art interesting.



Deals with visual weight in an artwork.



The size relationship of parts to a whole and to one another.



Unity is the feeling of wholeness in a work of art.

STEP 4




Paste the wiggle eyes and pompom to make its eyes and nose. Finally, draw the face and mouth to complete it.

Your snail is complete! Try doing it on the page aside.




Paste the legs, teeth, and tongue as shown.



Paste wiggle eyes and the frog is ready to hop. Try doing it on the page aside.











STEP 5




Use the satin ribbon to make bow of the snowman and then decorate it as shown. Your snowman is ready!








