## Primary

Mixing different amounts of the primary colours can make all the colours of the colour wheel.



## Secondary

Mixing two primary colours make a secondary colour.



## Analogous

Colours that are neighbours on the wheel.



## Complementary

Colours opposite from each other on the colour wheel.



## Tertiary

Primary colours and secondary colours are mixed together.



## Monochromatic

A colour with its tints and shades. Tints are colours mixed with white. Shades are colours mixed with black.







# PRINCIPLES OF ART

We use the principles of art to organise the elements of art. It is the way we use elements to make the artwork more interesting.

## Pattern



Repetition of a motif shape, line, colour in a recognisable organisation.

## Rhythm



Indicating movement by the repetition of elements.

## Emphasis



The way an artist makes something in a work of art stand out.

## Variety



Different lines, shapes, colours, and textures to make work of art interesting.

## Balance



Deals with visual weight in an artwork.

## Proportion



The size relationship of parts to a whole and to one another.

## Unity



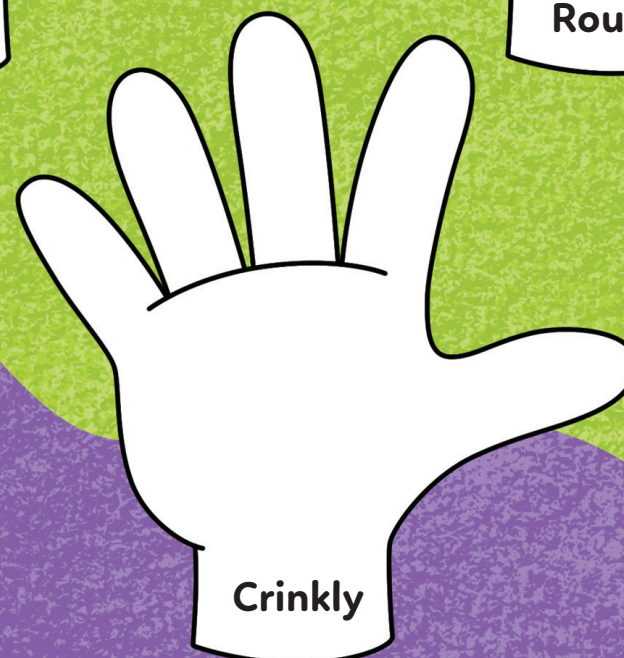
Unity is the feeling of wholeness in a work of art.

Paste the wiggle eyes and pom-pom to make its eyes and nose. Finally, draw the face and mouth to complete it.
















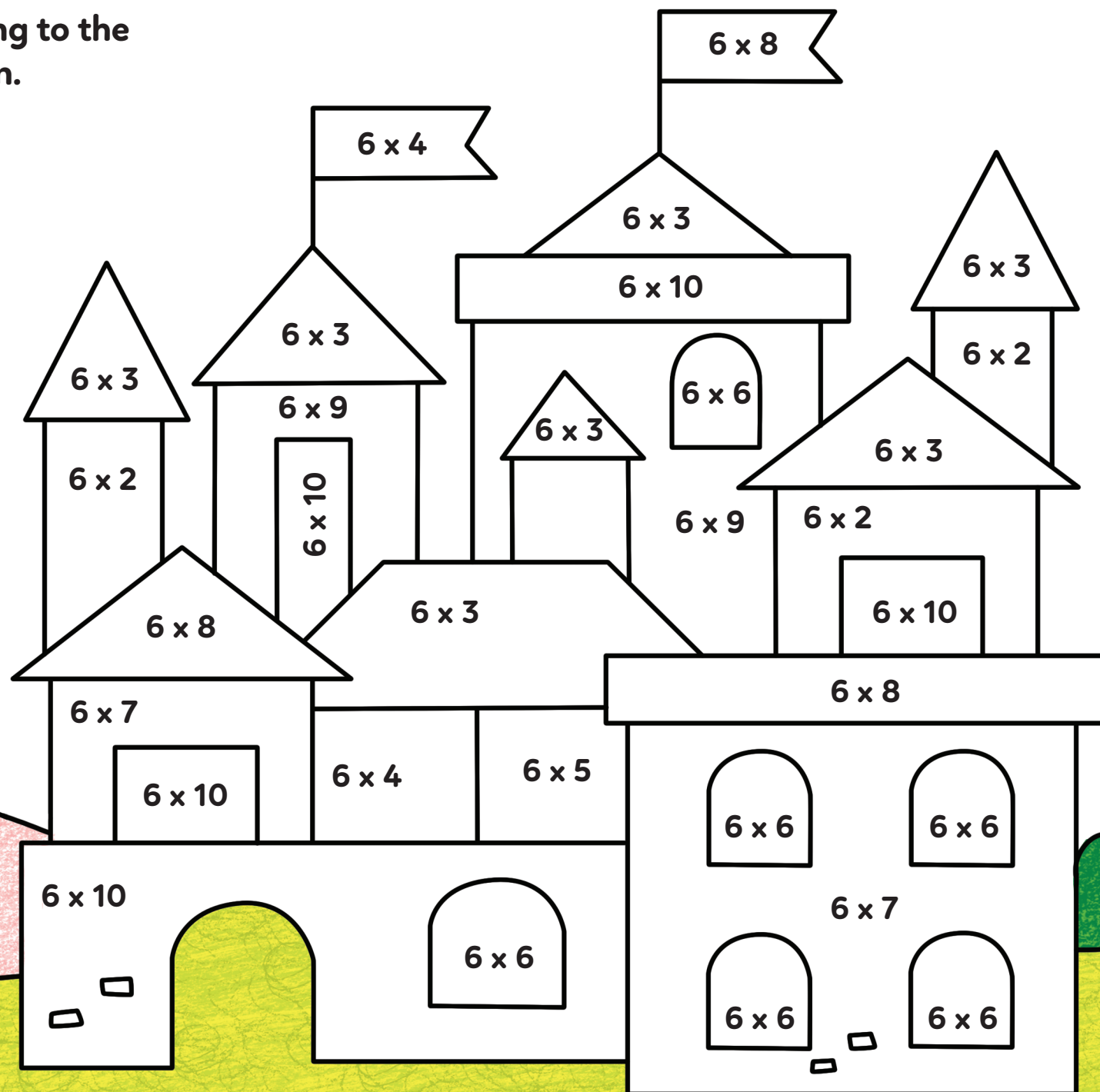

STEP 1



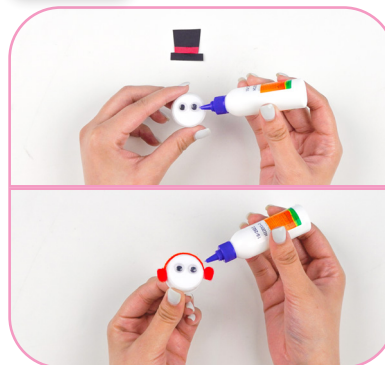
Cut the black sheet to make hat of the snowman as shown.

Use the satin ribbon to make bow of the snowman and then decorate it as shown. Your snowman is ready!



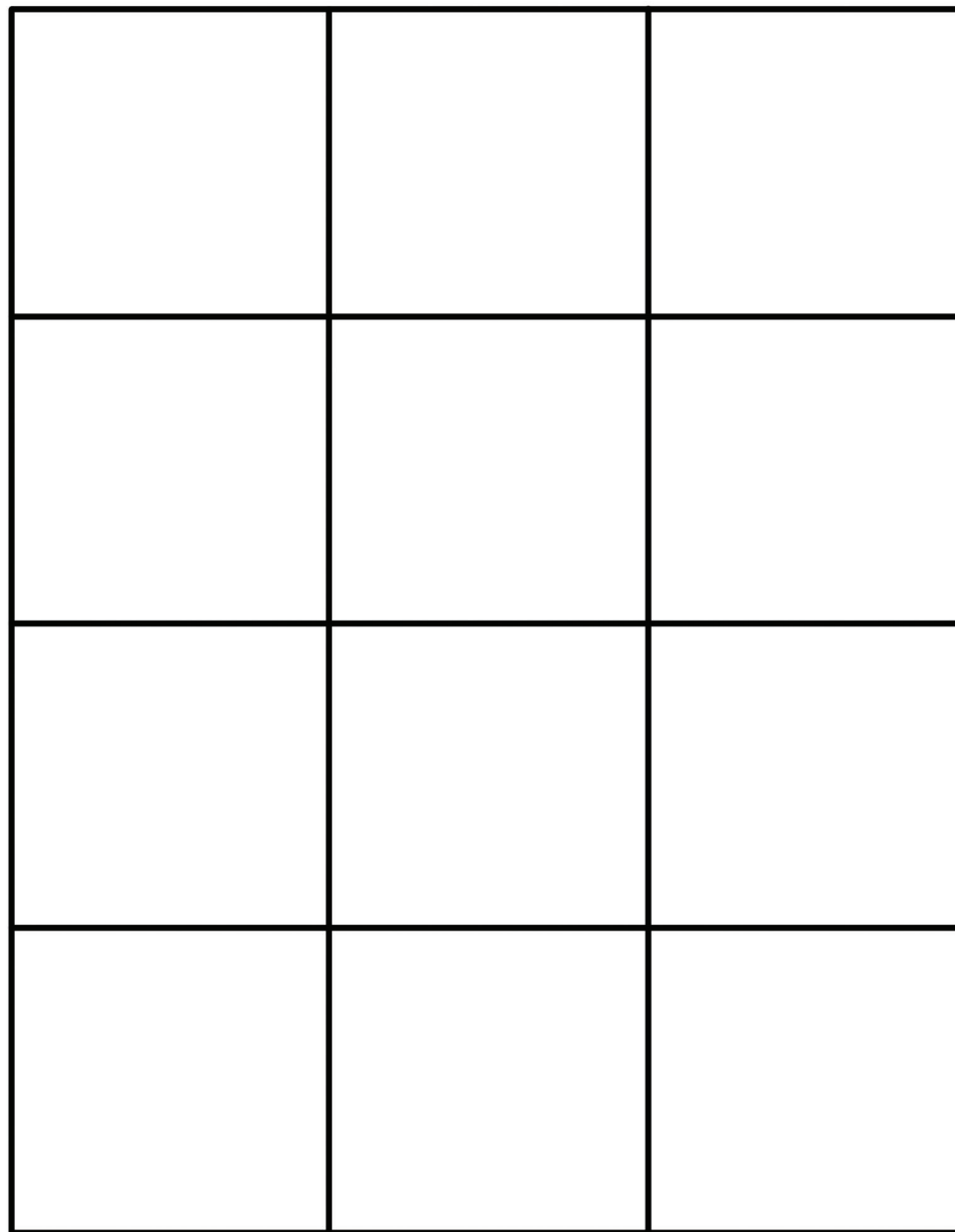
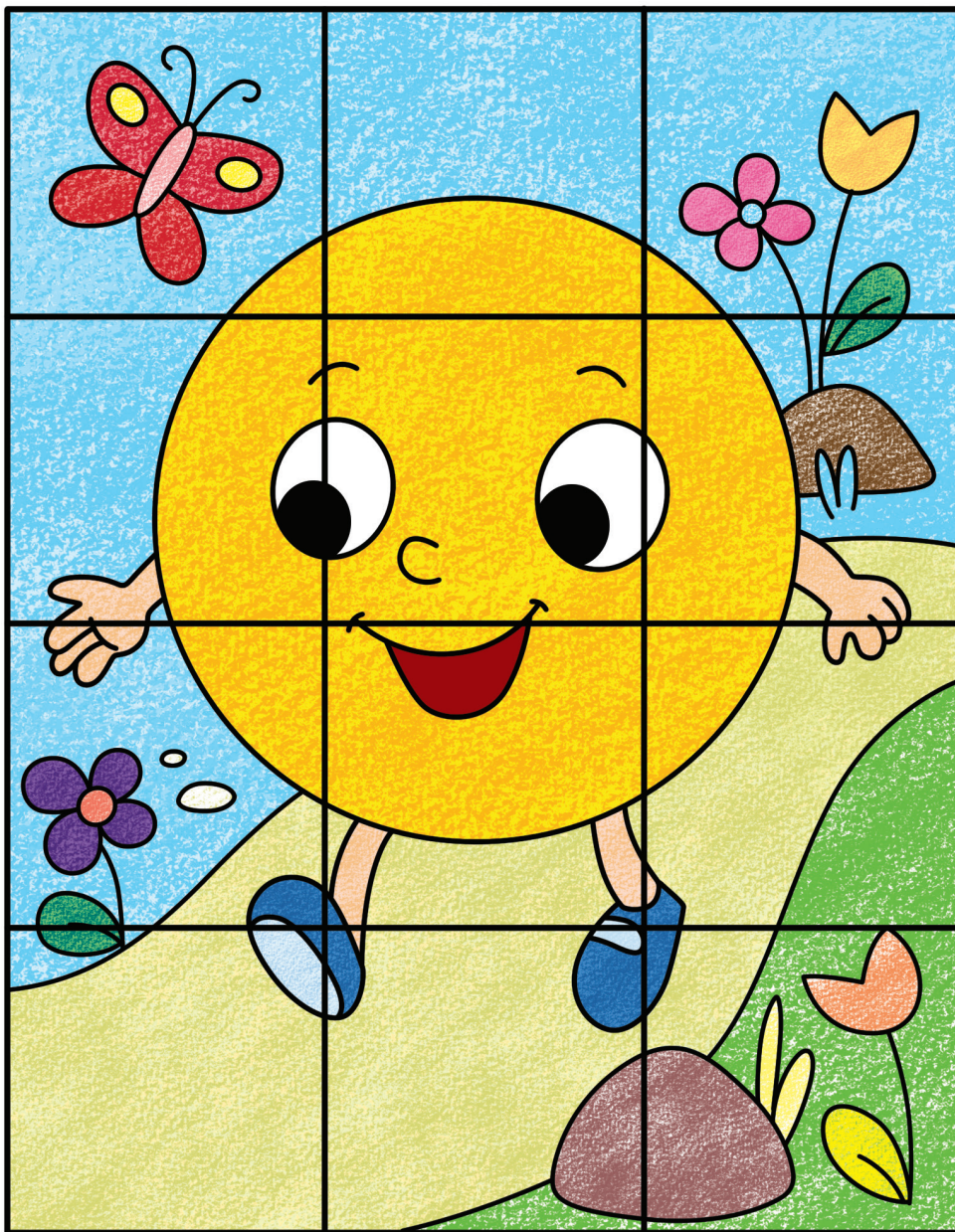
