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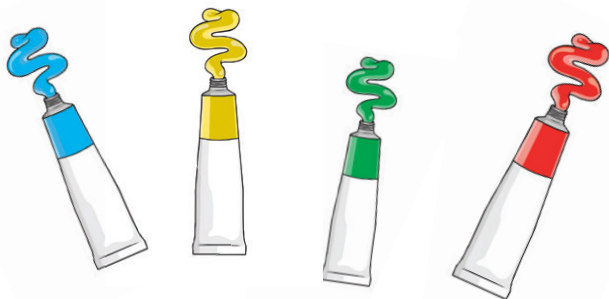
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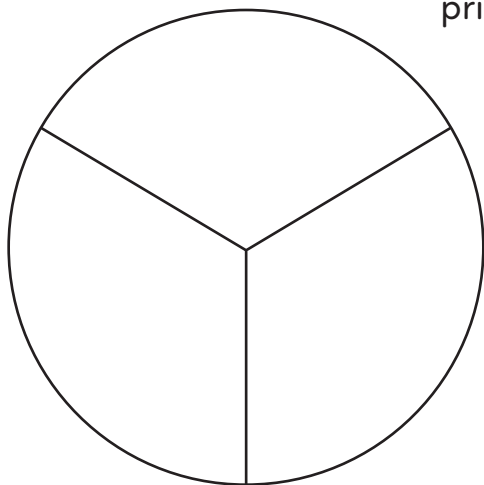
COLOUR THEORY



Colour theory is a way of organising colours and considering how they work together. Knowing about colours and their relationships to one another can help artists create balance, chaos, contrast and even evoke certain emotions too. Can you use some paints to explore colour in this activity?

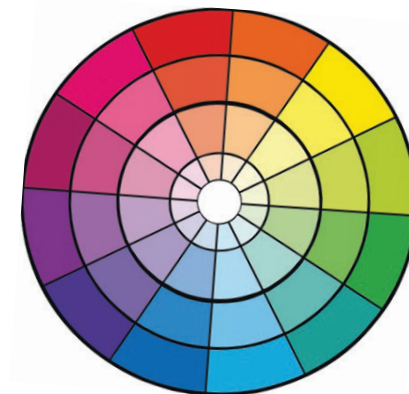
PRIMARY COLOURS

The **Primary Colours** red, yellow and blue cannot be made by mixing other colours. All other colours are derived from the primary colours.



COLOUR WHEEL

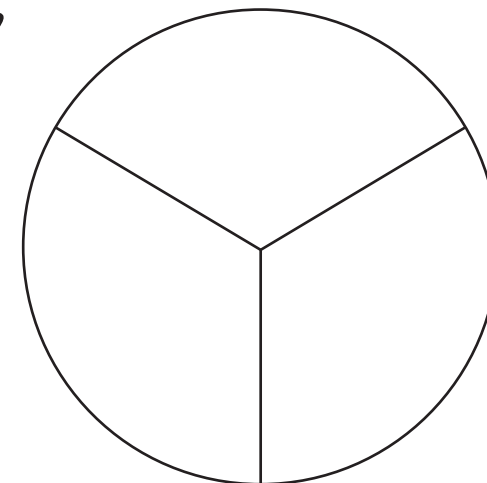
The colour wheel was first developed by Sir Isaac Newton. This is a 12-part colour wheel, showing the colours in a logical order.



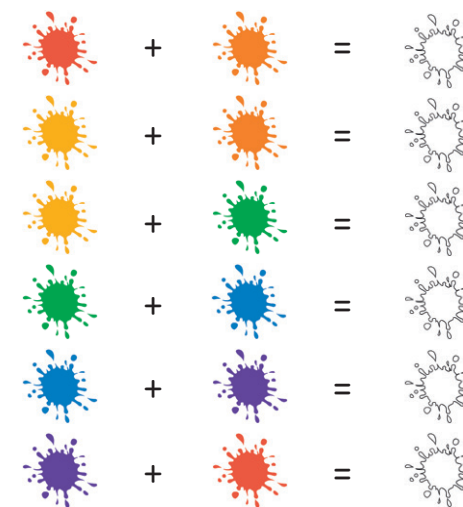
SECONDARY COLOURS

The **Secondary Colours** green, orange and purple are made by mixing primary colours.



TERTIARY COLOURS



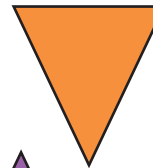
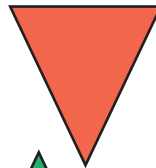
Tertiary colours yellow orange, red orange, red purple, blue purple, blue green and yellow green are made by mixing a primary colour and a secondary colour.



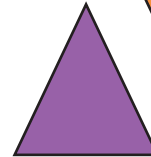
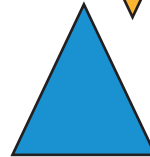
WARM AND COOL COLOURS

Red, yellow and orange are closely associated with items that are **warm**, like the sun and fire. Green, blue and purple are connected to **cool** items, such as ice and water.

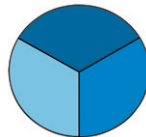

ANALOGUE COLOURS

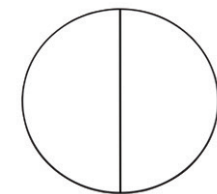
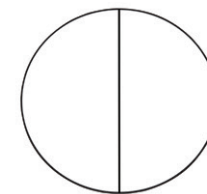
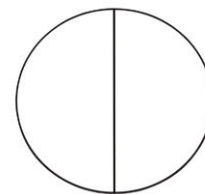


Analogue colours are any three colours that are next to each other on the 12-part colour wheel. Analogue colours create harmony when used together. Can you come up with three analogue combinations?



COMPLEMENTARY COLOURS

Complementary colours are opposite to each other on the colour wheel. They contrast with each other and they are used to create an impact. Can you find three possible complementary colour combinations?



COLOURS AND EMOTIONS

Colours can evoke feelings and reactions. Artists might choose to use a particular colour, or combination of colours, because they want people to experience an emotion when viewing their work. What emotions do you associate with these colours?



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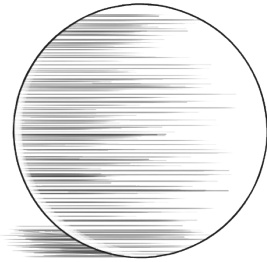


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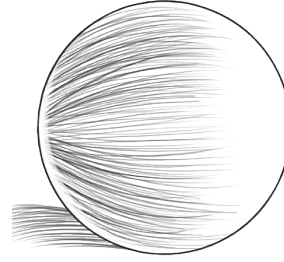
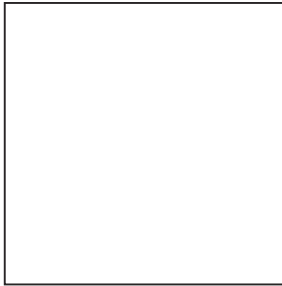

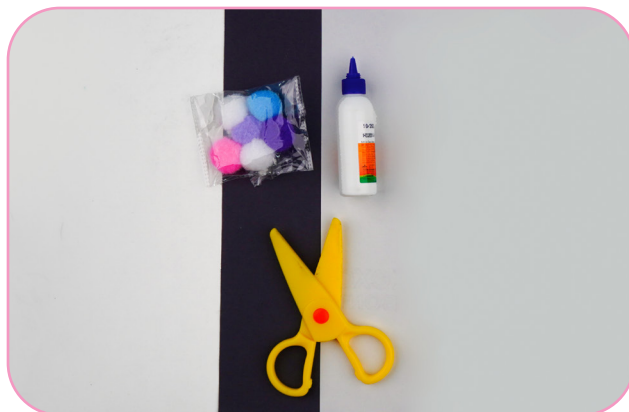




HEDGEHOG

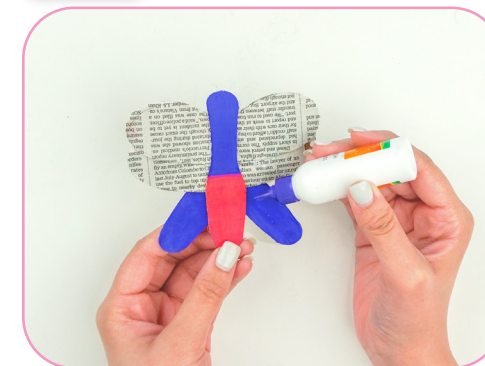
Cut the newspaper in the shape of the wing as shown above.

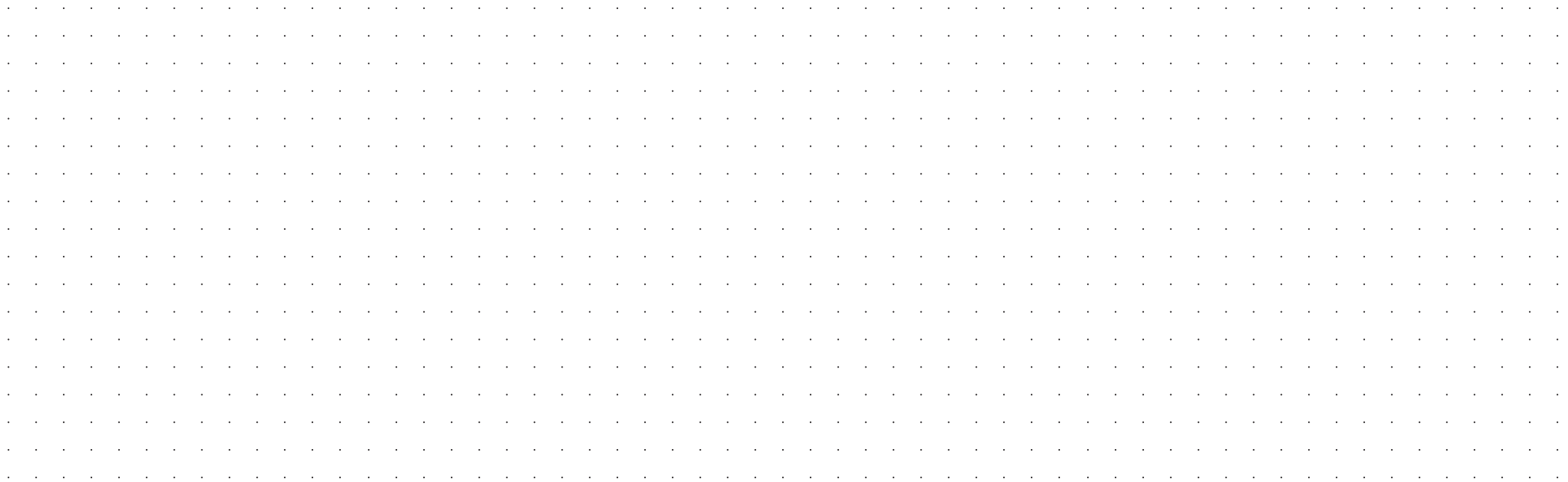
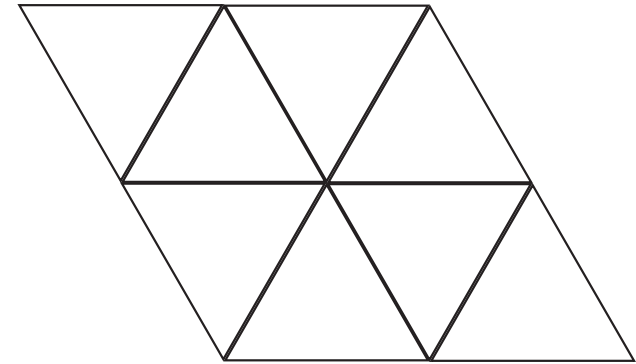
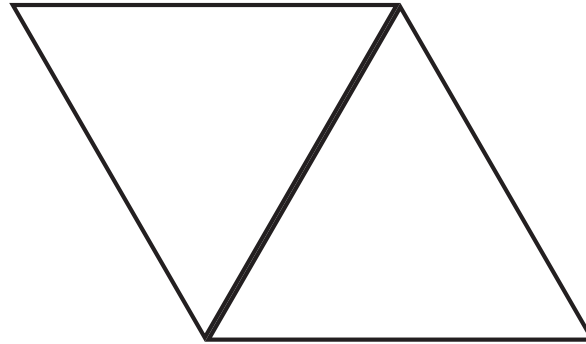
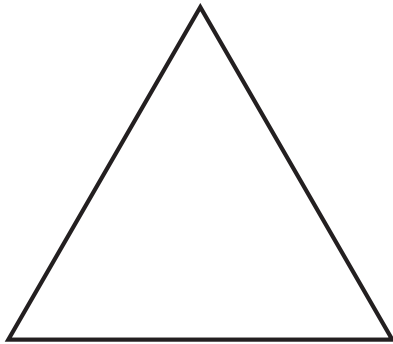


TESSELLATION

Try tessellating the shape to make a pattern. Draw your tessellation onto the isometric paper.

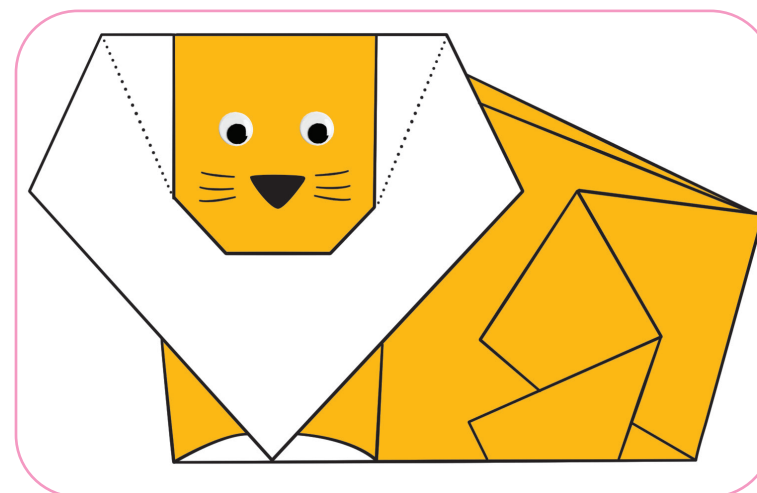
