Ladakh

Ladakh is the highest plateau in India.
Ladakh means 'land of high passes'.

It is bordered by Himachal Pradesh to the south, the union territory of Jammu and Kashmir to the west, the Tibet Autonomous Region to the east, and the Karakoram Pass in the far north.

Leh is the capital and the largest town in Ladakh, followed by Kargil.

The Leh district contains the Indus, Shyok and Nubra river valleys. The Kargil district contains the Suru, Dras and Zaskar river valleys.

Ladakh is the largest and the second least populous union territory of India. It is one of the most sparsely populated regions in India.

Kerala

Kerala is a small state, located on the south-western coast of India. It is a lush-green state also known as '**God's Own Country**'.

Kerala is bordered by the states of Karnataka to the north and Tamil Nadu to the east and by the Arabian Sea to the south and west.

Thiruvananthapuram (Trivandrum) is the capital city of Kerala. Most of the people in Kerala speak Malayalam, its official language.

Thiruvananthapuram, Kozhikode, Kochi, Kollam, Thrissur, and Kannur are important cities of Kerala.

Onam is the harvest festival celebrated in Kerala.

Kathakali is the classical dance form. It is a blend of dance, music and acting and dramatizes stories, which are mostly adapted from Indian epics.

The **elephant** is the state animal of Kerala.





Kerala is also known as the spice garden of the world.

Kalaripayattu, a sport of Kerala, is regarded as 'the mother of all martial arts in the world'.

There are 44 rivers in Kerala, out of which 41 flow westward while only 3 flow eastward. Periyar, Pumba and Chalakudy are main rivers.
